## General Guidelines & Discipline

The purpose of discipline is to teach acceptable behavior, not merely a set of rules. By setting and enforcing club standards, AWANA leaders attain a consistent standard of acceptable conduct.

**AWANA uses a three-strike method as a discipline device. This is used anytime during the club to discipline individual clubbers who are disruptive or misbehaving.**

**"Strike One"** - The clubber will be warned by the Director or person in charge.

**"Strike Two"** - If misbehavior continues they will be warned again and may be asked to sit out of the activity, or remain with an adult for remainder of the night.

**"Strike 3"** - If the clubber still refuses to behave appropriately, their parents will be called.

- **NO RUNNING** before, during, or after club, except during Game Time.
- **NO FOUL LANGUAGE** or GESTURES will be used before, during, or after club.
- **DISPLAY CARE** and RESPECT for all church property, leaders, and others.
- **OBEY** adults the **FIRST** time they ask.
- **Absolutely NO BULLYING** will be tolerated.

## How Parents Can Help:

- Please bring your child to club no earlier than 5:20pm, this gives our leaders time to get here.
- Help your child remember to bring their Handbook and Bible to club each night.
- Encourage good behavior from your child.
- Make sure to sign your child in if they need to ride the van. (Please only use the van if absolutely necessary. If you can pick your children up, that helps us greatly!)
- Make sure your child wears his/her uniform to club.
- Contact your child's Leader with questions or concerns. If after talking to the Leader, the issue is not resolved, contact the Club Director or AWANA Director.
- Remind your child to spend time each day on verses. Memorizing is hard work, they need your encouragement!
- All parents are welcome to attend any club, any night, as a visitor with their child, but need to check in.
